






Paul VI 1963-1978






1878-1978 Diocese of Pittsburgh







Dear Father Gavron:

You and your people are blessed in celebrating a century of Catholic life in Scottdale. I feel a very special part of this celebration, as my father's people were part of the pioneers there. My grandmother, who brought the family out of Ireland, died in 1883, the year after the first Parish Church was built. She is buried in the family plot in the Parish Cemetery.

Unique is the fact that two pastors account for more than 75 years of service to the Parish. After less than a year in the beginning, Father Thomas McEnrue was succeeded by the beloved Father Michael A. Lambing. His tenure of 52 years is the longest for any priest in this diocesan area.

The modern pastors, Monsignor Schneider, Monsignor Schroth and yourself, followed the 26 years of the ministry of Father Patrick J. Graney. Each pastor, supported by able associates, nurtured the faith of the people to give us one of the strongest parish units in the Diocese.

Nor can we ever forget the work of the Sisters of Charity there. For 89 years Saint John the Baptist School has been a landmark in the community. For a decade, 1923-33, a high school program, the first Catholic high school in Westmoreland County, served the area.

The Depression of the early 30's was especially severe. It closed both school programs for nearly a decade. The grade school opened again in 1941. Father Graney struggled to sustain his people during this bitter experience.

1962 was a special year in the Parish. The last Mass in the old Church was offered on June 20. The new Church and School were dedicated July 14, 1963. Many feel the Parish is about ready for a new Church building to separate areas for the worship and the social programs for the parishioners.


The Parish is well known for the sacrificial spirit of its people. Hundreds of families stem from the many marriages blessed there this past century. Here is the primary reason for which any Catholic Parish exists.

22 priests, 2 religious brothers and 44 religious sisters call Scottdale home. 32 of these Sisters serve the apostolate of our beloved Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill. These form that "servant Church" which Vatican II describes as the support of families struggling to raise children in the fear and love of the Lord.

May the second century be as blessed as the first.



### History of St. John the Baptist Parish

The beginning of St. John's dates back to the year 1870. Prior to this time, the spiritual needs of the people in the Scottdale-Mt. Pleasant area were attended by the pastor of St. Vincent's Church, Latrobe. In the Fall of 1870, Immaculate Conception Church in Connellsville was established and our area became one of its missions.

The next six years saw the development of the B&O and the Pennsylvania railroads, the building of the Furnace and Rolling Mill, the opening of coal and ore mines and the erection of the coke ovens. During this period, Mass was offered at private homes and sometimes at the Ore Mines.

In March, 1876, "The Little Church on the Hill" (the present site of St. Joseph's in Everson) was purchased to better serve the needs of the rapidly growing population. Two years later, it was decreed that the "mission" become a separate parish with definite bounds and that St. John the Baptist be its patron saint. We had truly begun. Fr. Thomas McEnrue was appointed as our first pastor in September, 1878. His pastorate continued until the appointment of Fr. Michael A. Lambing in July, 1879.

The congregation continued to grow at such a rate that an addition, known as "The Kitchen" became a necessary addition to the church. Still the need of an even larger church was imperative.

Lots on S. Broadway were bought for the new building in March of 1881 and the contract awarded for the erection of a red brick building with a seating capacity of 400. The cornerstone was laid in May of the same year. A small frame house was also built for the pastor. The congregation began using the new church as soon as the floor was laid. Dedication services were held September 3, 1882.

St. John's cemetery consists of two five-acre sections divided by Hornertown Road. The old section on Rt. 819 was dedicated in 1883; the huge granite cross was erected there in 1914. The new section on Loucks Lane was dedicated in 1949.

Our parishioners now numbered about 2,500 and were pentecostal as to tongues and lived in a radius of many miles from the church. Within the original boundaries of our parish, the following churches evolved: St. Joseph's, Everson; Transfiguration, Visitation, and Pius X (formerly St. Joseph's and St. Bernardine's), all in Mt. Pleasant; St. Stanislaus, Calumet; St. Florian's, United; Forty Martyrs, Trauger and St. John the Baptist Byzantine Church, Scottdale.

In May, 1889, land was purchased for a convent and a four-room brick schoolhouse. The school was opened in September of that year with the Sisters of Charity from Seton Hill as teachers; they resided in the newly built convent. The Sisters of Charity have been the only Order to be with our school through the years.

The community continued to expand with new industries and so did our need for adequate facilities for the school children. The Total Abstinence Society Hall on S. Broadway, erected in 1891 under the direction of Fr. Lambing, was used to provide more classrooms.

A new rectory was built at the corner of Church Street and S. Broadway in 1893 and remained in use until 1962.

The parish continued to grow and in 1906 it became necessary to add an annex to the church. Also, an expansion of the school was made in 1914 and again in 1917. Besides having an eight-grade elementary school, ours became, in 1923, the first Catholic High School in Westmoreland County.

In April, 1931, having served St. John's for fifty-two years, Fr. Lambing died. Fr. Patrick J. Graney succeeded him in July of the same year. When the Great Depression struck the nation and the parish, one of his most unhappy tasks was to close the high school forever in June, 1933, due to lack of funds. The following year the grade school was also forced to close its doors; it was not to reopen until 1941. Eighth-grade graduates who wished to continue their Catholic education attended Immaculate Conception High School in Connellsville. At mid-term of 1964, the newly built Fr. Geibel High School, a diocesan school staffed by several religious orders, including the Sisters of Charity, as well as lay teachers opened for grades nine through twelve. Since then, our area students have the option of attending school there.

In 1951, the Diocese of Pittsburgh was divided, and St. John's became a part of the Diocese of Greensburg under the leadership of The Most Reverend Hugh L. Lamb. He died in 1959 and was succeeded by our present Bishop, The Most Reverend William G. Connare, in 1960. The Most Reverend Norbert F. Gaughan was appointed Auxiliary Bishop in 1975.

After twenty-six years of devotion to St. John's Fr. Graney passed away in November, 1957. In March, 1958, Fr. Andrew J. Schneider assumed the pastorate and immediately began charting plans for the redevelopment of new structures for St. John's. These included the building of a church-school on the site of the old rectory and the already present church and the buying of property for a new rectory.


Fr. Schneider was transferred in December, 1960; Fr. Gerald A. Schroth replaced him as pastor, and implemented the plans of his predecessor. Early in 1962, the building campaign was launched. A residence located on the corner of Church Street and S. Broadway was purchased and completely renovated. This became the new parish house. The old rectory and church were razed; the building of the church-school was begun. During the time of construction, the cafeteria and auditorium of the old school served as temporary church quarters, and still retained its teaching functions. In March, 1963, the cornerstone for our present two-story church-school was laid; the ground level being the church and the upper floor the eight classrooms. Masses were said in the building for the first time on May 12, 1963; the children were in their new classrooms that Fall.

Fr. Schroth was made Monsignor in May, 1962. He died in September, 1972. Our current pastor, Fr. William M. Gavron, a former assistant at St. John's was appointed to take Monsignor's place in October, 1972.


Demolition of the old school began in the Spring of 1976; the land on which it stood has been paved and is now a parish parking lot. In May, 1978, two parish-owned buildings on property adjacent to the convent were demolished. Soon the convent, too, will be razed, providing St. John's with a site for the erection of a new church. When this is accomplished, the facilities of the school will encompass the use of the entire present building.

The celebration of our centennial year finds us looking back on a hundred years of history rich in service, love, gratitude and true devotion to God and His people. It also inspires us to continue this pattern into the next hundred years.






Rev. Patrick J. Graney July 1931—November 1957 (R.I.P.)






Views from the front and back of the old brick church.






